

SPS grants for master students

The Saclay Plant Sciences network (SPS) offers grants for students enrolled in the teaching programs in its perimeter:

- Plant Sciences" programs of the Integrative Biology and Physiology master's degrees (M1 and/or M2) at Université Paris-Saclay or Université Paris-Diderot,
- DA AgroParisTech BIOTECH
- DA AgroParisTech PISTv
- DA AgroParisTech PPE

Application deadline: June 1st 2019

General information

Up to 10 grants will be allocated each academic year.

The successful candidates will receive:

- in M1: 8000 euros
- in M2 or DA: 6000 euros (to which will be added the internship stipends)

The students who received a SPS grant in M1 and who are accepted in M2 will receive the grant in M2 (except in case of refusal by the grant commission).

Eligibility

- 1) To be eligible to the SPS Grants, students must apply to one of the following teaching programs mentioned above
- 2) Only students accepted to one of these programs will then be considered for the SPS grant.
- 3) Acceptance of a SPS Grant commits the students to carrying out their internship within the **SPS laboratory network**.

Application procedure for SPS grants

only for student applying to the “Plant Sciences” program (M1 or M2), master Integrative Biology and Physiology at Paris Diderot University

- 1) **Apply first to the academic teaching program** (M1 or M2 Biologie int grative et Physiologie, parcours Sciences du V g tal) **on the dedicated online site of Paris Diderot University** (<https://etudes-formations.univ-paris-diderot.fr/lapplication-ecandidat>)
- 2) **Apply THEN to the SPS-Grants (deadline : June 1st 2019)**

Grant application must be :

- **performed online on the following site**

- **sent by mail** for confirmation to **Christine Lelandais-Bri re**, supervisor of the Plant Sciences master at Paris Diderot University (christine.lelandais@univ-paris-diderot.fr)

This application must contain:

a- **the following informations:**

- Your family and first names
- Which teaching program are you applying to?
M1 (first year of the master program) **OR M2** (2nd year of the program)

b- **a motivation letter**

- downloaded online or attached to the mail of confirmation, in pdf format, file name “complete name of the applicant-M1 or M2-Plant Sciences-Diderot”:
- and justifying:
 - the choice of this teaching program in the frame of the applicant’s career project and
 - the importance of the grant for enrollment in this teaching program.

Application to the SPS-grant will not be considered in absence of the previous application to the master program.

Key dates

Application to the master program AND to the grant:	before 1 st June 2019
Selection interviews for the master ^{1,2} :	last two weeks of June 2019
Final admission results to the master’s program	before 15 th July 2019
Admission results for the SPS grant for master students	before 15 th July 2019
Beginning of the courses: first week of September 2019
